In this role you are working closely together with the Accounting & Financial Control team to understand actual results to be able to develop a realistic forecast and budget.

Capex reporting & control: As capex controller you keep the overview of capital expenditures including preparation of the capex report by value stream on monthly and quarterly basis, as information for our CEO, CFO and Board.

Project Management: You are actively involved in different improvement projects related to the financial planning cycle of bpostgroup and in design of new reports to improve steering information for bpostgroup management.
